

**ORDER SETTING THE 2015 PROPERTY TAX RATE  
FOR CLAY COUNTY, TEXAS**

Whereas, the Clay County Commissioners' Court has voted to set the tax revenue levy for Tax Year FY2015 in order to provide Funds with which to meet the Budget requirements of the County, and to pay the expenses necessarily incurred in connection with the Services provided by the County to Clay County Residents: therefore,  
**BE IT ORDERED BY THE COMMISSIONERS' COURT ON SEPTEMBER 8, 2014:**

**That the levy for Tax Year FY2015 is an ad valorem tax of \$ 0.65518 per \$100 assessed valuation on all taxable property within the County.**

**This tax rate is hereby adopted in the following components:**

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<b>2015 Total Ad Valorem Tax Rate</b>	<b>\$0.65518</b>


