

CONTRACT FOR JOINT ELECTION

This contract for joint election is made by and between

Midway Independent School District

Hereinafter called school,

and

Kenneth Liggett, County Judge, on behalf of Clay County Texas,

hereinafter called the contracting officer is based on the following:

The school and the contracting officer have determined that the following contract be made and entered into for the purpose of entering into a joint election in accordance with *Texas Education Code Sec. 11.0581*.

POLLING LOCATIONS

The school must provide ballots to each polling location that lies within the school district, so that voters may participate in the school election at the polling place of the voting precinct in which the voter resides, in accordance with *Texas Election Code Sec. 43.004*:

Early Voting (all precincts)- Clay County Courthouse Annex, 214 N Main, Henrietta

Precinct 1 (SE Henrietta)- Henrietta Senior Citizens Center, 216 N Hancock, Henrietta

Precinct 10 (Vashti)- Vashti Community Center, 6097 FM 1288, Vashti

Precinct 20 (Midway)- Bluegrove Baptist Church, 1980 FM 172, Bluegrove

Precinct 24 (Bellevue)- Bellevue City Hall, 136 4th St, Bellevue

Precinct 26 (Buffalo Spgs.)- Buffalo Springs Community Center, 6302 FM 174 E, Buffalo Springs

Precinct 32 (Windthorst)- Veitenheimer Residence, 3100 Veitenheimer Rd, Windthorst

BALLOTS & EQUIPMENT

Ballots containing school races will be separate from the Nov. 4, 2014 General Election ballot.

Any programming of voting equipment needed by the school will be separate from the programming paid for by Clay County. The county leases Automark Voter Assist Terminals to cities and schools for a fee set by the Clay County Commissioners' Court. The set rental rate is \$250.00 per election machine and a delivery/pick up fee of \$200.00 per location. The school will pay all programming fees, ballot costs, election supplies, and any other costs associated with the school election. The school will be responsible for any election site support and/or training. The school will be responsible for conduct of Absentee Voting by Mail, tabulation of all votes, and any canvassing or reporting of vote totals. The school is responsible for pickup and delivery of school ballots to polling places before and after election (polling place doors will be locked at 7:00 p.m.).

POLL WORKERS

EARLY VOTING

The school should provide a sufficient amount of ballots to the county for Early Voting at the Courthouse Annex Oct. 20- Oct. 31, 2014. The county-appointed early voting clerks shall distribute ballots to qualified voters as requested. The county reserves the right to charge the school for a portion of the salary paid to the Early Voting clerks. Approx. 8% of Clay County's voters are registered voters in Midway ISD, therefore, Midway ISD would be responsible for approx. 8% of the EV clerks salary at \$12.00 per hour, 40 hours per week for two weeks, which equals \$153.60 to Clay County for use of early voting clerks.


ELECTION DAY

The school is responsible for placing a poll worker in each precinct to qualify voters (with a possible exception of Pct. 32, which is located inside a small private residence). If the number of registered voters in a precinct who reside in the school district is less than 10, the school may utilize the county-appointed poll workers. If the school utilizes county poll workers, the school remains responsible for the delivery and pick up of school ballots before and after election, as outlined above.

The City or School agrees to pay Clay County, located at 214 N. Main St., Henrietta, Texas, any fees owed within FIFTEEN days of the school Election Day, in which the election was held, and the equipment was used.

Clay County has no obligation to conduct city and school elections. Clay County holds no responsibility for the conduct of a city or school election. The County Clerk cannot render advice or render any service requiring the use of legal skills or knowledge, in accordance with *Texas Government Code Sec. 81.101*.


