

Excessive Force Policy

Resolution No. _____ Excessive Force Resolution

A resolution establishing rules and regulations regarding the use of excessive force during nonviolent civil rights demonstrations, including physically barring entrance to a facility or location which is the subject of such demonstrations, and providing penalties for violations thereof: In the following Clay County, Texas, as follows:

ARTICLE I


Section 1: It is the policy of Clay County, Texas to prohibit the use of excessive force by the law enforcement agencies within its jurisdiction against any individual engaged in non-violent civil rights demonstrations. The County also prohibits the physical barring of any entrance to, or exit from, such a facility within its jurisdiction.

ARTICLE II

Section 1 It is the policy of the County to enforce this policy to the full extent allowed by law.
