ACTION PLAN FOR LARGE INCIDENTS IN CLAY COUNTY (The purpose of this document, a large scale incident will be considered as being one in which the incident escalated to the fourth department or more)

- 1. ANYTIME INCIDENT ESCALATES TO 4th Dept. Emergency Management will be requested.
- 2. When incident escalates to 4 or more departs, IC post will be established .
- 3. Command post will be stationary to allow for proper staging area, tender placement, Rehab, and first aid station.
- 4. Staging will be established away from Command Post and Staging Area Manager (STAM) will be assigned by IC

5. IC will:

- a. Establish command post (Designated Radio Channel)
- b. Notify DC 3 of situation(TDEM District Coordinator, Lance Liggett DPS Wichita Falls)
- c. Assign "Division Supervisors "to Divisions of fire (A&Z)
- 1. Division 1 Supervisor will be "A" (Designated Channel)
- 2. Division 2 Supervisor will be "Z" (Designated Channel)
- 3. Assign companies to Divisions

- 4. More Divisions will assigned as need arises.
- d. Ask dispatch for current and forecasted weather conditions
- e. Advise S.O. (Sherriff Office) of situations and ask for Traffic Control when needed
- f. Ask for Mutual Aid and have companies report to staging area for assignment
- g. Monitor both (DESIGNATED CHANNELS) to assist Commanders
- 6. When assigned to Division, notify SUPERVISOR of that Division and ask for assignment. Stay with Division until assignment completed or requested by SUPERVISOR to change assignment

Division SUPERVISOR

- 1. SUPERVISOR can request more resources from the IC
- 2. Once company receives assignment, in Division, said company will have all radio traffic go thru Division SUPERVISOR and not to IC unless it is deemed emergency radio traffic.
- 3. **Division SUPERVISOR** will notify IC of status of companies (ie: flats-out of water-fuel-member to hot need relief ect...)
- 4. Once IC is notified, by **SUPERVISOR**, replacements will be dispatched from staging area. Once original unit is repaired or refueled they will be reassigned by STAM

- 5. Division Supervisor must protect heavy equipment, being used, during operations. (ie: bull dozers, loaders, road graders)
- 6. No units will leave Division until **SUPERVISOR** is advised and orders are approved. ("No free lancing".)

STAGING

- 1. STAGING AREA MANAGER (STAM) will be assigned from IC
 - a. Will be in charge of keeping a log of incoming and outgoing units
 - b. Will be in charge of Tender operations and water supply
 - c. Will monitor radio from IC (Designated Channel) and dispatch units as IC request
 - d. Will coordinate with IC for supplies needed at scene

LOGISTICS

- 1. Officer be assigned by IC
 - a. Will setup rehab station designated by IC
 - b. Will coordinate supplies needed
 - c. Furnish Medical attention when required
 - d. Notify IC if member needs to be removed by POV or Ambulance
 - e. Keep a log of members rehabbed thru station
