

Agreement for Professional Services

This agreement is for professional services between Jennifer Schindler and Clay County, Texas.

This agreement will be for a term beginning January 1, 2019 thru September 30, 2019. This agreement may be extended by mutual agreement of the parties, and approval by the Clay County Commissioner's Court.

Jennifer Schindler agrees to provide services as a Juvenile Case Manager for the Justice Court of Clay County, Texas, as well as all school districts in Clay County, Texas. Duties include, but are not limited to; providing assistance to school districts in filing juvenile cases; managing juvenile cases to ensure compliance with the Court's orders; developing and presenting seminars to clientele targeted to reduce truancy; and assisting school administrators with attendance issues.


Jennifer Schindler has discretion as to a work schedule required to complete all assigned and required duties.


To operate within current funding constraints, Jennifer Schindler and the Clay County have agreed to a contract fee of \$500 per month; if more funding becomes available, the contract fee will be re-negotiated and if funding sources are depleted this agreement may be terminated.

It is the agreement of the parties that Jennifer Schindler:


- 1.) will provide her own health insurance (county insurance will not be provided by this contract employment);
- 2.) will be a contract employee, and will not receive any county employee benefits as a result of this employment contract; and
- 3.) understands that she will receive an IRS Form 1099 at the end of each year.






