

**ORDER SETTING THE TAX YEAR 2020/FY 2021  
PROPERTY TAX RATE  
for  
CLAY COUNTY, TEXAS**

Whereas, the Clay County Commissioners Court has voted to set the tax revenue levy for Tax Year 2020/FY2021 in order to provide funds with which to meet the budget requirements of the County, and to pay the expenses necessarily incurred in connection with the services provided by the County to Clay County residents.

**THIS TAX RATE WILL RAISE MORE TAXES FOR MAINTENANCE AND OPERATIONS THAN LAST YEAR'S TAX RATE. THE TAX RATE WILL EFFECTIVELY BE INCREASED BY 2.86 PERCENT AND WILL RAISE TAXES FOR MAINTENANCE AND OPERATIONS ON A \$100,000 HOME BY APPROXIMATELY \$20.00: therefore,**

**BE IT ORDERED BY THE COMMISSIONERS COURT ON SEPTEMBER 28<sup>th</sup>, 2020:**

That the levy for Tax Year 2020/Fiscal Year 2021 is an ad valorem tax of \$0.720000 per \$100 Assessed valuation on all taxable property within the county.

This tax rate is hereby adopted in the following components:




