The court recognizes the importance of a reliable and secure local area network that serves all county staff's needs. When problems occur, they must be resolved quickly and affordably.

The CCMH currently employs a highly qualified technical staff that understands the importance of network functions, network security, and typical troubleshooting problems. The court understands the importance of having local staff available to provide support.

- The Clay County Commissioners' Court and the Clay County Memorial Hospital agree that CCMH staff will provide the following at no cost for county-owned equipment:
- Manage and maintain
 - Microsoft File Server
 - Microsoft Exchange Server
 - DNS server
 - DHCP server
 - Virus Protection and Firewall
 - Data Backup
 - Provide Technical Support and Troubleshoot
 - All desktop and laptop computers
 - All printers
 - All wireless access points
 - All point to point data links
 - Monitor and Update Virus Protection and Software Updates
 - All computers and servers
 - Advise and assist in the development and implementation of the county technology plan, including disaster recovery


Clay County Commissioners' Court will provide a budget for:
