FY'22 Community Project Funding (CPF) Requests

Submission Deadline: April 15, 2021

NOTE: Due to a limited number of requests allowed by each congressional office, the office of Congressman Ronny Jackson (TX-13) will only consider proposals that are

- 1.) submitted by organizations based in Congressional District TX-13; and
- 2.) Affect the constituents of Congressional District TX-13.

Community Funding Projects **MUST** meet all guidelines established by the Committee to be accepted:

- ❖ Requestor **MUST** be able to demonstrate community support for the project. Acceptable examples of community support include letters from elected officials, press articles, newspaper editorial board pieces, a state-intended use plan or community development plan, city council resolutions.
- ❖ Requestor **MUST** submit 3 examples of community support to the office of Rep. Ronny Jackson in order for the request to be considered.
- ❖ The project or requesting entity must have **NO financial ties** to the Member or his/her family.
- ❖ Funding must be for **FY'22 ONLY**.
- ❖ If the project would normally require a funding match or cost share by a non-federal entity, then the requesting entity will need to demonstrate that it can and will provide this match if it makes a CPF request.
- ❖ The recipient of the CPF must be a governmental entity or 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization. Requests made by for-profit entities are **NOT** permitted.
