

Applications for ballots by mail must be received no later than the close of business on **Oct. 22, 2021**.

Federal Postcard Applications must be received no later than the close of business on October 22, 2021 (if not a registered voter). FPCA's for registered voters may be received until close of business on October 22, 2021. An FPCA voter who is not registered to vote may apply to receive a limited Federal-race only ballot Oct. 18, 2021 – Oct. 22, 2021.
