

**ORDER SETTING THE 2023 PROPERTY TAX RATE
FOR CLAY COUNTY, TEXAS**

Whereas, the Clay County Commissioners Court has voted to set the tax revenue levy for Tax Year FY2023 in order to provide Funds with which to meet the Budget requirements of the County, and to pay the expenses necessarily incurred in connection with the Services provided by the County to Clay County Residents: therefore,

BE IT ORDERED BY THE COMMISSIONERS COURT ON SEPTEMBER 12, 2022:

That the levy for Tax Year FY2021 is an ad valorem tax of \$0.6262 per \$100 assessed valuation on all taxable property within the County.

This tax rate is hereby adopted in the following components:

General Funds M & O	\$0.4662
Road & Bridge Funds	<u>\$0.1600</u>
2023 Total Ad Valorem Tax Rate	\$0.6262

THIS RATE WILL RAISE MORE TAX REVENUE FOR MAINTENANCE AND OPERATIONS SERVICE, AND ROAD AND BRIDGE THAN LAST YEAR'S TAX RATE.
