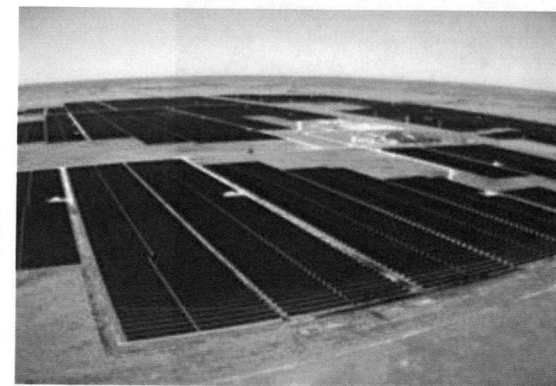
Cypress Creek in Texas

Investing in the state
of Texas since 2014

- **17 projects** in operation: 182 MWdc
- **9 projects** developed with partners: 575 MWdc
- **11 projects** under development: 2,357 MWdc
- **Generated \$803 million** of investments in Texas to-date.
- **Paid \$36 million** of taxes in Texas, to localities, counties and ISDs.
- **Powering over 20,000 Texas homes** with solar powered electricity.
- **Reduced 470,170 metric tons** of carbon dioxide from clean energy.
- **Highly experienced** in developing and building Transmission Scale solar projects in ERCOT.

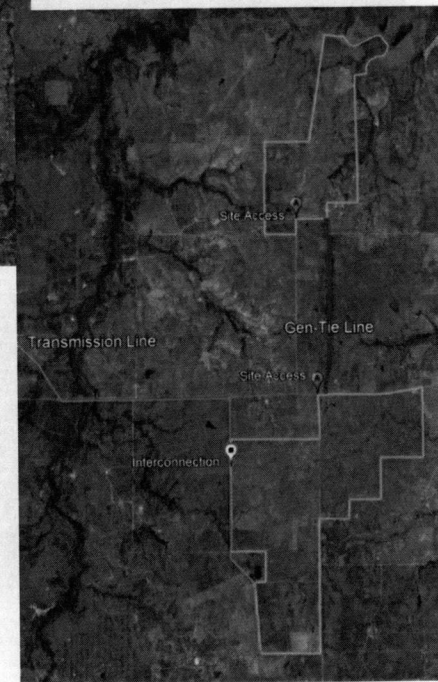
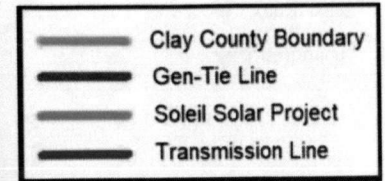
Project Overview

725 MW Solar Project in Clay County

- Includes solar modules, inverters, transformers, racking equipment, foundations, internal access roads and security fencing.
- Construction will begin in late 2024 and continue for one year into the end of 2025.
- The project will consist of two array areas, connected by a 3 mile powerline.
- The project will interconnect to an existing 345kV Transmission Line

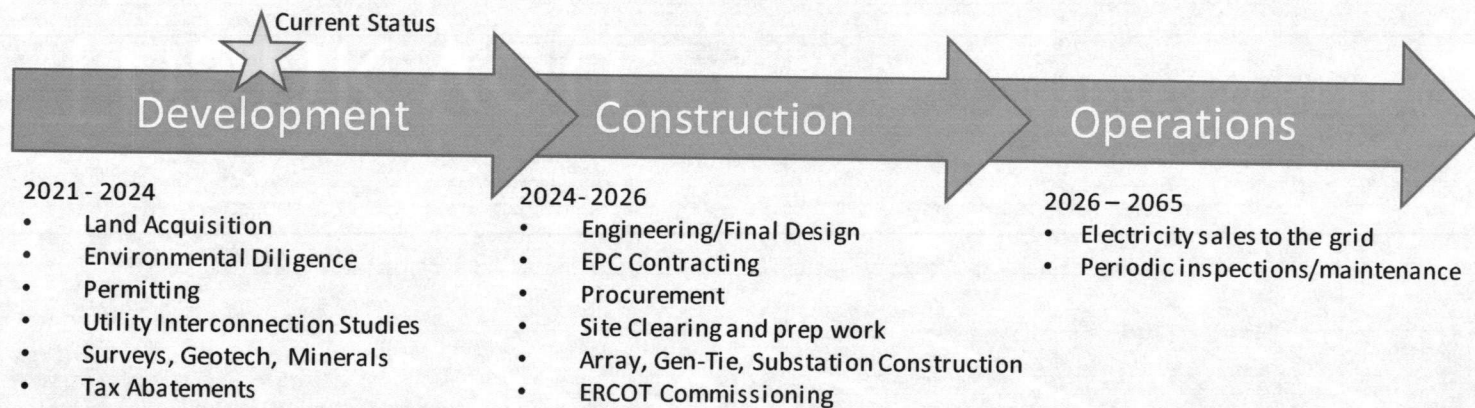
Community Benefits

- Project will employ 300 temporary construction workers
- Local economic benefits to the surrounding communities and local business during the construction period.
- Power homes and businesses across TX with clean, renewable electricity without emitting pollutants into our air or creating hazardous wastes.
- Unlike other sources of energy, there is no mining, drilling, or transportation of fuel.
- Increase in tax base creating significant financial benefits for Henrietta ISD and Bellevue ISD.
