

**ORDER SETTING THE 2024 PROPERTY TAX RATE  
FOR CLAY COUNTY, TEXAS**

Whereas, the Clay County Commissioners Court has voted to set the tax revenue levy for Tax Year FY2024 to provide Funds with which to meet the Budget requirements of the County, and to pay the expenses necessarily incurred in connection with the Services provided by the County to Clay County Residents: therefore,

**BE IT ORDERED BY THE COMMISSIONERS COURT ON September 11, 2023:**


That the levy for Tax Year FY2024 is an ad valorem tax of \$0.5745 per \$100 assessed valuation on all taxable property within the County.


This tax rate is hereby adopted in the following components:

General Funds M & O	\$0.4145
Road & Bridge Funds	<u>\$0.1600</u>
2024 Total Ad Valorem Tax Rate	\$0.5745


