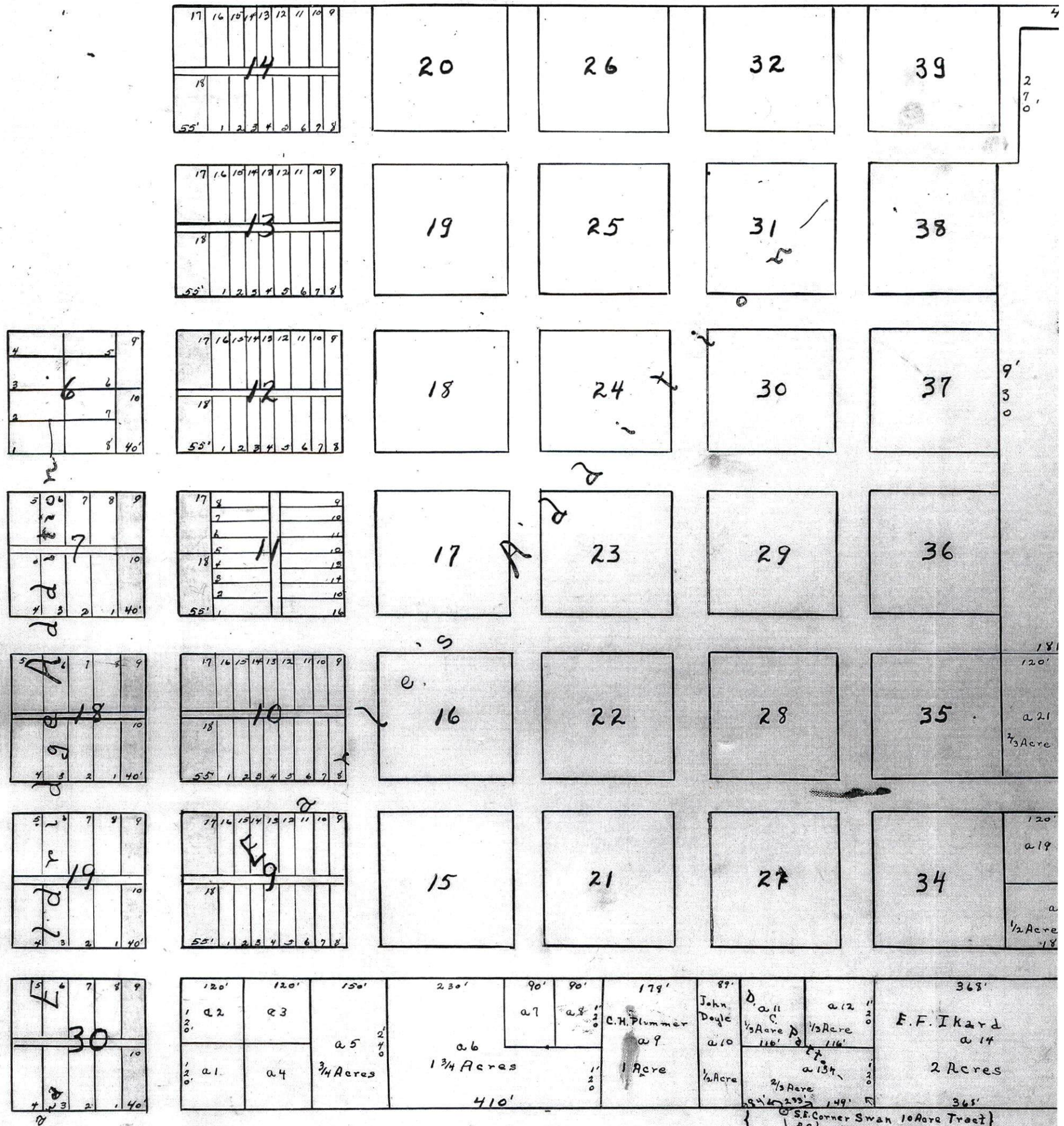


Correction Plat of Howeth & Eldridge and Earle



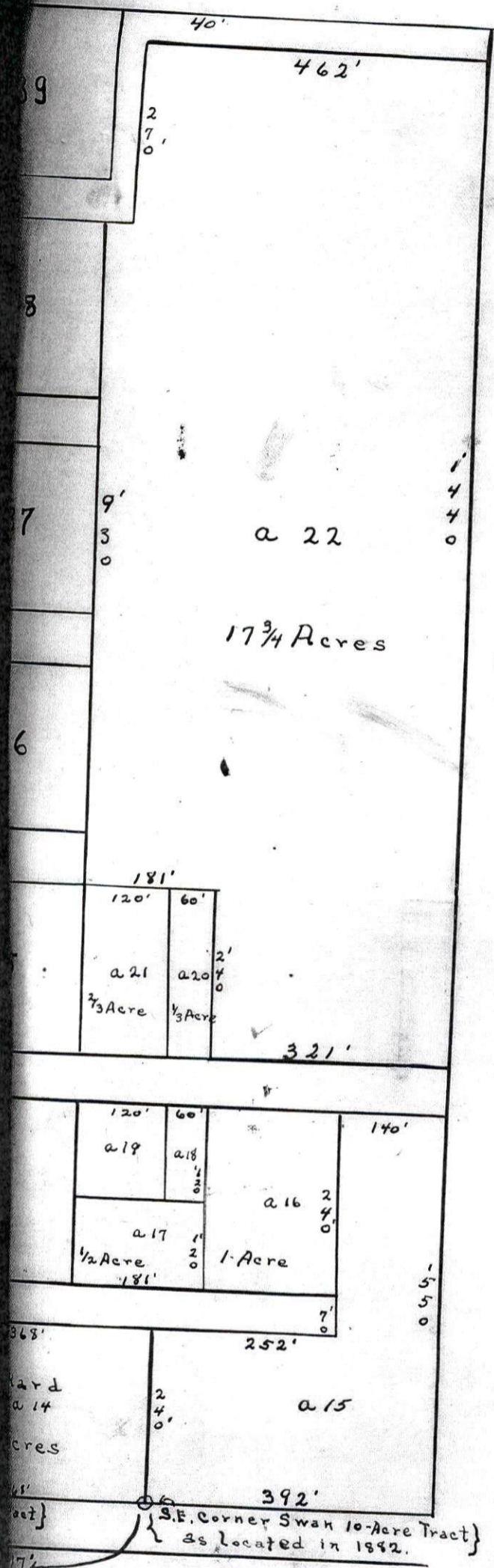

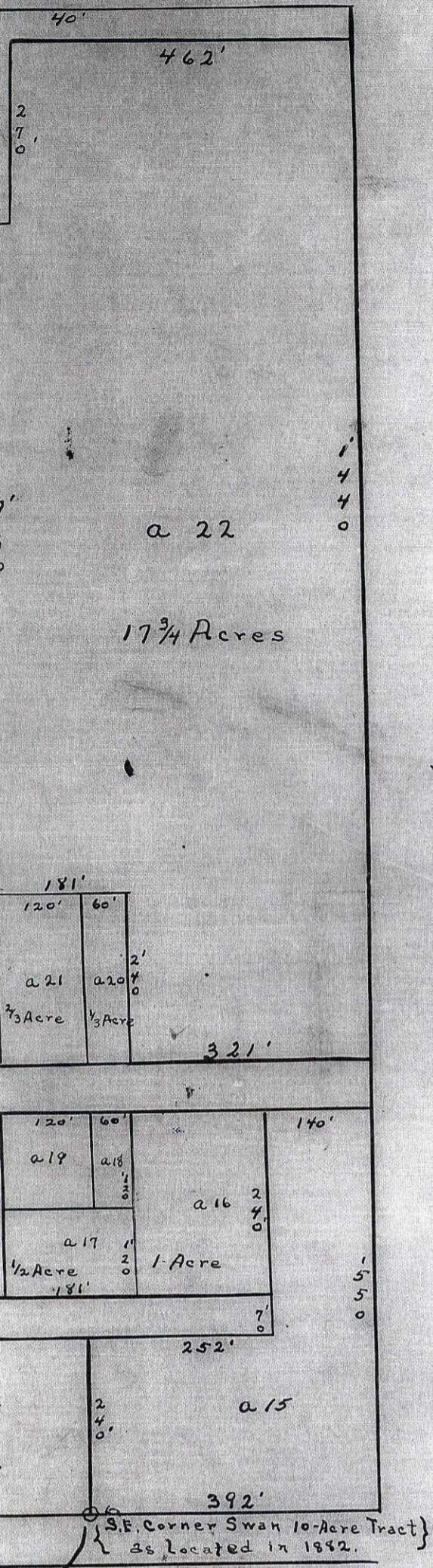
