

RESOLUTION- ALPR

A RESOLUTION OF THE COMMISSIONERS COURT OF CLAY COUNTY, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE SHERIFF TO ENTER INTO A MULTIPLE-USE AGREEMENT WITH THE TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION ALLOWING THE INSTALLATION AND OPERATION OF AUTOMATED LICENSE PLATE RECOGNITION CAMERAS IN TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION RIGHT-OF-WAY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, The Commissioners Court of the County of Clay has determined the addition of Automatic License Plate Recognition (ALPR) Cameras will increase public safety and aid the Sheriff's Office in its crime prevention efforts and strategies; and

WHEREAS, The Commissioners Court desires to engage with the Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) and asks that Flock Safety be allowed to place ALPR Cameras in TxDOT right-of-way's on behalf of the County of Clay; and

WHEREAS, The Commissioners Court finds it to be in the public interest to authorize the Sheriff to Sign a Mutiple-Use Agreement with TxDot.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSIONERS COURT OF CLAY COUNTY, TEXAS, THAT:

Section 1.

The Commissioners Court hereby authorizes the Sheriff to enter into a Multiple-Use Agreement with TxDOT for the installation and operation of ALPR Cameras in TxDOT right-of-way.

Section 2.


This resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
