### Disaster Declaration Extension

WHEREAS the County of Clay, on the 30th of April 2025, continues to suffer widespread or severe damage, injury, or loss of life or property (or there is imminent threat of same) resulting from record rainfall amounts. Since April 1, 2025, the National Weather Service has issued 28 Severe Thunderstorm Warnings, 10 Tornado Warnings, and 8 Flash Flood Warnings.

WHEREAS Clay County continues to receive flash floods that damage roads recently repaired from the last storms.

And

WHEREAS, the COUNTY JUDGE of CLAY COUNTY has determined that extraordinary measures must be taken to alleviate the suffering of people and to protect or rehabilitate property,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED BY THE COUNTY JUDGE OF CLAY COUNTY:

That a local state of disaster is hereby declared for CLAY COUNTY pursuant to §418.108(a) of the *Texas Government Code*.

Pursuant to §418.108 (b) of the *Texas Government Code*, the state of disaster shall continue for a period of not more than seven days from the date of this declaration. This declaration is approved by the Commissioners Court to extend our local state of disaster until June 3, 2025, by the COMMISSIONERS COURT of CLAY COUNTY.

Pursuant to §418.108(c) of the *Texas Government Code*, this declaration of a local state of disaster shall be given prompt and general publicity and shall be filed promptly with the COUNTY CLERK.

Pursuant to §418.108(d) of the *Texas Government Code*, this declaration of a local state of disaster activates the COUNTY emergency management plan.

That this proclamation shall take effect immediately from and after its issuance.
