



**Amendment to Memorandum of Agreement Between
Texas Animal Health Commission
and
Clay County Sheriff's Office**

This Amendment to the Memorandum of Understanding ("Amendment") is entered into by and between the Texas Animal Health Commission ("TAHC") and the Clay County Sheriff's Office ("CCSO"), collectively referred to as the "Parties."

RECITALS

WHEREAS, the Parties previously entered into a Memorandum of Agreement ("MOA") effective through August 31, 2025, to provide law enforcement assistance on traffic stops in support of TAHC operations;

WHEREAS, the Parties desire to renew the MOA and continue their collaboration under the same terms and conditions;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual promises and covenants contained herein, the Parties agree to amend the MOA as follows:

1. The term of the MOA is hereby extended for an additional period of one (1) year, commencing on September 1, 2025, and ending on August 31, 2026, unless terminated earlier in accordance with the original MOA.
2. Except as expressly amended herein, all other terms and conditions of the original MOA shall remain in full force and effect.
