Main, Henrietta, Texas, to consider such items of business as are deemed necessary including the following:

1. Court to approve minutes of previous meeting(s).
2. Court to approve Line Item/Budget Amendments.
3. Court to consider and possibly approve payment of bills relating to Clay County Memorial Hospital (CCMH).
4. Court to consider and possibly approve all accounts and reports relating to the finances of Clay County, audit and settle accounts, and direct payments.
5. Court to hear from any person desiring to appear before the court.
6. Court to consider and possibly approve 2026 pro rata distribution of proceeds from the Tobacco Settlement Permanent Trust Account.
7. Court to consider and possibly approve purchase of 30-inch True White Single Sink Bathroom Vanity for 97th District Court, purchase price of \$199.00.
8. Court to consider and possibly approve purchase of Jeld-Wen 30-in x 80-in primed solid core 2-panel door for 97th District Court, purchase price of \$309.00.
9. Court to consider and possibly approve purchase of steps with handrail with anti-slip mats for 97th District Court, purchase price of \$89.00.
10. Court to consider and possibly approve awning and/or porch for annex front center and north doors.
