WHEREAS the Commissioners' Court agrees to provide applicable matching funds for the said project as required by the Homeland Security grant application; and

WHEREAS the Commissioners' Court agrees that in the event of loss or misuse of the Office of the Governor's funds, the Commissioners' Court assures that the funds will be returned to the Office of the Governor in full.

WHEREAS, the Commissioners' Court designates Mike Campbell, County Judge, as the grantee's authorized official. The authorized official is given the power to apply for, accept, reject, alter, or terminate the grant on behalf of the applicant agency.

WHEREAS the Commissioners' Court designates Danja Bloodworth as the grantee's financial officer. The financial officer is authorized to submit financial and/or programmatic reports or to alter a grant on behalf of the applicant agency.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Commissioners' Court approves submission of the grant application for the Cyber Security Grant to the Office of the Governor.
