

## **CLAY COUNTY COMMISSIONERS COURT RESOLUTION**

### **IN SUPPORT OF CLAY COUNTY COURTHOUSE RESTORATION THCPP ROUND XIV APPLICATION**

**WHEREAS** this is a Resolution supporting the efforts of Clay County to commence restoration of the Clay County Courthouse located on the square in Henrietta, Texas; and

**WHEREAS**, the Clay County Courthouse has been a county government building for more than 142 years, since 1884, and has served as the judicial and cultural center of Clay County, since that time; and


**WHEREAS**, because of its functional and historical value, our Clay County Courthouse is worth preserving for the next 142 years, and the restoration of our courthouse would not go to waste, and every square foot contained therein would be put to governmental use; and

**WHEREAS** Clay County has updated its Master Plan and submits this application in Round XIV to the Texas Historical Commission pursuant to the Texas Historic Courthouse Preservation Program for the restoration and construction funds for said courthouse; and

**WHEREAS** the proposed Texas Historic Courthouse Preservation Program grant award is contingent upon compliance with the terms of a Funding Agreement if Clay County is awarded such a grant.


**NOW, THEREFORE**, be it resolved that the Commissioners Court of Clay County, Texas, affirms by this vote its willingness to accept the obligation of the County's matching funds required by any Funding Award subject to the grant's final terms reviewed, and to contribute the funding necessary to complete the project, and to enter into the aforementioned Funding Agreement, and to hereby declare its complete and unreserved support for this important project to preserve the Clay County Courthouse for future generations.
